

EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY POLICY

The employment policy of Uvex Safety is to provide equal opportunity to all persons. Our company, therefore, has made a commitment to equal employment opportunity through a positive and continuing Affirmative Action Program. No employee or applicant for employment will be discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, otherwise qualified disabled or veteran status.

To implement these policies, Uvex Safety will continue to:

A. Recruit, hire, train and promote persons in all job classifications without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, otherwise qualified disabled or veteran status. Uvex Safety does not discriminate on the basis of national origin or citizenship status as provided under the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986;

B. Base decisions on employment so as to further the principle of equal employment opportunity;

C. Insure that promotion decisions are in accord with the principles of equal employment opportunity by imposing only valid requirements for promotional opportunities;

D. Insure that all personnel actions (including but not limited to compensation, benefits, transfers, layoffs, return from layoffs, company-sponsored training, education, tuition assistance, social and recreational programs) are administered without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, otherwise qualified disabled or veteran status.
